Greater Noida authority appoints REPL to prepare Master Plan 2041

The development of master plan will be undertaken in eight stages which include reviewing of the existing planning framework, assessing the implementation of the existing master plan and consultations with the stakeholders to formulate the strategy.

Based on the detailed analysis and assessment of the development status and current trends, REPL will develop alternative strategies to achieve the goals and objective for the Vision 2041. The notified area is approx 38,000 Hectares.

REPL will also assist the authority in notifying and finalizing the draft perspective plan, the master plan, zonal development plans, zoning regulations, and action plans.

"Master Plan will includes transport plan, real estate and industrial development plan, disaster management plan, and plan for low income housing. Master Plan 2041 will have elements of Mixed-Use Development and Transit Oriented Development for sustainable development.
