NEW DELHI: Madurai Smart City (MSCL) has appointed Delhibased Rudrabhishek Enterprises (REPL) as project management consultant (PMC) for monitoring and supervising of underground sewerage scheme (UGSS). The project is of Madurai Corporation for North of Vaigai River Phase II (Package I, II and III).

REPL will support MSCL in overall project management which includes project planning, budgeting, supervising, managing, evaluating, reporting and coordination to ensure timely project implementation.

It will also prepare Quality Assurance Plan (QAP) and Inspection Test plan (ITP) to improve water supply and sanitation facilities.

Pradeep Misra, CMD-REPL said, "As the city is expanding rapidly, the civic infrastructure, especially water supply and sanitation, require an effective and improved sewerage system."

MSCL is currently engaged in developing the lakes restoration & rejuvenationcum-green NMT (Non-Motorized Transport) corridor project in Madurai. For supporting this project, MSCL has onboarded REPL to monitor the sanitation project implementation.

Dr. Harish Sharma, ED, REPL said, "DPR has been prepared and contractors have already undertaken detailed field surveys, given the variations (as applicable) and have commenced the work."

REPL has currently been working on several smart city projects that include – Varanasi, Indore, Kanpur, Moradabad, Dehradun, Itanagar, Jabalpur, and Vellore.

The company is also working on BIM consultancy for Chennai Metro Rail Phase II, sewerage management system for Thiruvananthapuram, online Building plan approval systems (OBPAS) in Uttar Pradesh, rural water supply scheme in Assam, among others.
