MADURAI Smart City Limited (MSCL) has appointed Delhi-based infrastructure consultancy company, Rudrabhishek Enterprises Ltd (REPL), as Project Management Consultants (PMC) for monitoring and supervising the Underground Sewerage Scheme (UGSS).

REPL has already been working on several Smart City projects in Varanasi, Indore, Kanpur, Moradabad, Dehradun, Itanagar, Jabalpur and Vellore.

The project aims at providing individual underground drainage connections to 45,000 households north of Vaigai river. A detailed project report has already been prepared and contractors have undertaken detailed field surveys, given the variations (as applicable) and have commenced the work.

According to corporation officials, around 30 per cent of the works have been completed. Meanwhile, REPL will support Madurai Corporation in overall project management which includes project planning, budgeting, supervising, managing, evaluating, reporting and coordination to ensure timely project implementation.

“The company will also prepare Quality Assurance Plan (QAP) and Inspection Test plan (ITP) to improve water supply and sanitation facilities,” said Dr Harish Sharma (ED-REPL).

Pointing out at the rich culture and heritage of Madurai, Pradeep Misra (CMD-REPL) assured the company would bring in innovative experiences of sanitation projects from eight other smart cities.
