REPL awarded JJM project in Burdwan

KOLKATA: Rudrabhishek Enterprises Ltd. (REPL), a leading Delhi-based Infrastructure Consultancy Company, has been appointed by the West Bengal PHE Directorate to prepare detailed project report (DPR) for the piped water supply scheme in Katwa Sub-Division of Purba Burdwan district. This will cover 7 schemes spread across 98 villages.
